



Arvada K-8 Families and Students,

My name is Nate Broeckert and I am the new 21<sup>st</sup> Century learning Program Director at Arvada K-8. Though I come to you after the school year has already begun and amazing things are already happening, I am confident that this will be a smooth transition. This hope of this letter is to serve as a reminder about after school programming as well as to answer a few frequently asked questions.

### **When do after school programs take place at Arvada K-8?**

After school programs run from 3:15-4:15 (unless otherwise noted) Monday-Thursday. Programs run in 4 session increments (with the exception of the musical), the dates for those sessions are listed below. Registration forms are due back by the date indicated in next to session dates.

- Session 1- August 27<sup>th</sup>-October 19<sup>th</sup>. (Forms due by 8/22)
- Session 2-October 22<sup>nd</sup>- December 21<sup>st</sup> (Forms Due 10/17)
- Session 3- January 14<sup>th</sup>- March 8<sup>th</sup>. (Forms Due 1/9)
- Session 4- March 11<sup>th</sup>-May 10<sup>th</sup>. (Forms due 3/6)

### **Program Registration-**

Students who wish to be a part of after school clubs will need to fill out a registration packet once upon registering for clubs, and fill out a selection form. Once the registration packet is received, students can participate in clubs all year. If a student is interested in participating in a club they will need to return the selection form to their teacher or to the main office by the Wednesday prior to the week of the club starting. **Students will then receive a letter saying they are accepted into the club.** Clubs will be filled on a first come first serve basis, if a club is full students will then be placed on the waiting list. Students can continue to register for clubs through the fourth week of the session.

### **Program Dismissal-**

Most Clubs (unless otherwise noted) will run from 3:15-4:15, students will go be dismissed from class as usual then head to the cafeteria where they will be given a snack prior to club starting. Clubs will dismiss out of the front of the school at 4:15, please ensure an authorized pick up person is on site to pick students up at **4:15** (unless they are riding the activity bus which will leave promptly at 4:30). **Constant late pick up can result in a student no longer being eligible to attend programs.**
